

Literacy

In English, our Talk4Writing lessons will be based on the books "Lost and Found", "Jack and the Beanstalk" and other seasonal stories.

We will practice our sentence punctuation, phonic digraphs and tricky word spellings. We will recite prayers and poems. We will try to improve our handwriting. We will listen to non-fiction information books and the Easter story.

Computing

The children will be using a wide range of programs within all areas of the curriculum on the iPads and interactive whiteboard. They will follow the "Kapow" scheme on programming using Beebots and following instructions.

EAD

We will learn to draw plants from observation, make models, use different media, mix colours and learn about perspective. We will make a den at Forest School and a playground for teddy bears.

Physical Development

We will have Gymnastic coaching on Tuesday and Games skills on Friday. During the term, children will develop cooperation in partnerships and ball skills as well as improving fitness.

All about Animals and plants

Maths

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge beyond 10 and number bonds. We will investigate the meanings of "odd and even" double and half. We will make patterns, arrange shapes and build up mathematical vocabulary about more, less or the same.

RE

In R.E we will learn about special stories and the "good news" that Jesus Brings! We will learn about the meaning of Lent and follow our Christian values calendar.

Music

We will explore beats and rhythm making music and learn to play percussion in time. We will use percussion instruments to play simple rhythms and explore how they can be used creatively.

Please read several times each week and practice letter formation using letter families. Talk about plants, different countries and animal facts. Recognise numbers and use maths for counting and comparing.

UW The Natural World

In Science, we will be learning about seasonal change and keep a weather record. We will learn about life cycles of fish, birds, mammals and amphibians. We will look at Arctic and native animals, plants: how they grow and the signs of spring. We will grow runner beans.

UW Past and Present

This term we will learn about Mary Jones and her Bibles, in conjunction with "special stories in R.E. We will talk about how we have grown and changed.

UW People Culture and Communities

This term we will learn about life in the Antarctic. We will celebrate: Epiphany, Christingle, Valentine's Day, Mothering Sunday and Easter. We will get out and about in Pencombe!
