

## English

In English, our Talk4Writing lessons will be based on the books "Lost and Found", "Jack and the Beanstalk" and other seasonal stories.

We will practice our Year 1 sentence punctuation, grammar and use adjectives to describe. We will write prayers and poems. We will try to improve our handwriting. We will write non-fiction fact sheets and the Easter story.

## Computing

The children will be using a wide range of programs within all areas of the curriculum on the iPads and interactive whiteboard. They will follow the "Kapow" scheme on programming and computer systems.

## Art and DT

We will learn to draw plants from observation, make models, use different media, mix colours and learn about perspective. We will make a den at Forest School and a playground for teddy bears.

## Physical Education

We will have Gymnastic coaching on Tuesday and Games skills on Friday. During the term, children will develop cooperation in partnerships and ball skills as well as improving fitness.

## Maths

Maths will follow the White Rose scheme of work, focusing on basic skills and problem solving. We will be learning more number bonds and continue place value. We will record calculations and begin to recognise doubles and halves. In space shape and measure we will be learning about weight and height, length and volume.

## Geography

This term we will make maps and label maps of the world. We will learn about weather, climate and seasonal changes. We will keep a weather record.

## Music

We will explore beats and rhythm making music and learn to play percussion in time. We will use percussion instruments to play simple rhythms and explore how they can be used creatively.

## What you can do to help:

Please read several times each week and practice spellings. Talk about plants, different countries and animal facts. Recognise numbers to 100 and use maths for counting money and measuring. Practise letter formation.

## Science

In Science, we will be learning about seasonal temperatures and keep a weather record. We will learn about the features and life cycles of fish, birds, mammals and amphibians. We will look at Arctic and native animals, plants: how they grow and the signs of spring. We will grow runner beans.

## History

This term we will learn about Mary Jones and her Bibles, in conjunction with "special stories in R.E

## Religious Education

In R.E we will learn about special stories and the "good news" that Jesus Brings! We will celebrate: Epiphany, Christingle, Valentine's Day, Mothering Sunday and Easter. We will learn about the meaning of Lent and follow our Christian values calendar.

## PSHE

We will use the "Jigsaw" PSHE scheme to explore "Dreams and Goals" and "Celebrating Difference". Thinking and reflecting upon "What makes me special?" and "What do I want to achieve?"
