In English, our Talk4Writing lessons will be based on the stories "Handa's Surprise" and "Monkey see monkey do". We will practice our sentence punctuation and tricky word spellings. We will create prayers and poems. We will try to improve our handwriting. We will listen to non-fiction information books and traditional African tales.

Computing

The children will be using a wide range of programs within all areas of the curriculum on the iPads and interactive whiteboard. They will follow the "Kapow" scheme programming beebots and data handling.

Art and DT

We will explore pattern and colour mixing. We will create landscape scenes using layers of colour. We will design fruit salads and healthy meals. We will make fairground rides at the time of the May Fair.

Physical Development

We will have Gymnastic / dance coaching on Tuesday and Games skills on Friday. During the term, children will develop cooperation and stamina ready for sports day!

Maths

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge beyond 100 and number bonds. We will learn about division and multiplication, fractions, telling the time, directions, positional language and using money.

RE

In R.E we will learn the creation story and how to care for the world. We will find out about places of worship and think about why some places are sacred.

Music

We will use percussion instruments to play simple rhythms and explore how they can be used creatively. We will listen to "carnival of the animals" and create our own animal parade.

Science

In Science, we will continue to observe seasonal change, native plants and keep a weather record. We will learn about healthy eating, exercise and the human body. We will learn about different African animals and how they live. We will learn the meaning of "carnivore, herbivore and omnivore".

History

This term we will learn about Mary Kingsley and exploring Africa, Nelson Mandela, Rosa Parks and Greta Thunberg. We will talk about how we have grown and changed in our own lives.

Geography

This term we will label a world map, learn about life in an African village and compare it to Pencombe. We will celebrate Ascension Day, the Jubilee and join in all the school's Summer celebrations.

PSHE

We will use the "Jigsaw" PSHE scheme to explore the themes "Healthy me" and "Changing me" learning about growth and change.
